We are looking for a **dynamic and enterprising Operations and Quality Manager** with the ambition to reach world class standards in the production of Cameras and Smart Cameras for Traffic and Industrial applications. You will be **responsible for productivity, efficiency and profitability through the implementation of effective processes and performance improvements through lean methodology.**

You will manage a team of 22 people in Operations (Supply Chain, Production, and NPI) and 5 people in Quality (ISO 9001/ IRIS).

When you are fully aware of all processes of our local company, your expertise could be requested to help the other companies of the group located abroad.

Responsibilities

- Ensure that all products are manufactured in a correct, cost effective and timely manner in alignment with specifications and quality requirements
- Improve operational systems, processes and best practices that guarantee organizational well-being purchase materials, plan inventory and ensure warehouse efficiency → We want to reduce our product costs yearly by 10% to 20% and reducing our warehouse by at least 10% every year.
- Manage the Quality Management System (QMS) and ensure compliance. → Main goal is to reduce by 50% the Non Quality Costs in 2018.
- Manage the customer complaints driving containment actions, full analysis, poka-yokes (error proofing) and implementing short-term and long-term countermeasures. Perform root cause analysis and resolve problems.
- Develop, implement and manage key performance indicators (KPIs) for each area of responsibility and report highlighting deviations
- Manage logistics process, inventory maintenance, manufacturing, shipment and delivery, and returns on products.
- Read and comprehend legal documents, such as contracts or import/export agreements.
- Manage NPI team in order to develop new products on time, with the defined cost and quality
- Ensure that the function operates in accordance with any health, safety and environmental policies and procedures to ensure the safety and wellbeing of staff and visitors
